Mallory Young is an English professor at Tarleton State University where she teaches western world literature, British literature, and women's literature. In 2011, she was named a Regents Professor of the Texas A&M University System. Her essays, reviews, and poems have appeared in numerous regional and national publications. She has also published academic articles and book chapters on a variety of subjects including the *Odyssey*, Texas women's nonfiction, and European films. In recent years, she has focused primarily on the area of women's popular culture known as "chick culture." With Suzanne Ferriss, professor of English at Nova Southeastern University, she has edited two volumes of essays, *Chick Lit: The New Woman's Fiction* (Routledge, 2006) and *Chick Flicks: Contemporary Women at the Movies* (Routledge, 2008).
